NEW YORKER FEATURES

One glance into the interior of New Yorker and you're convinced this is a premium-line car. And no wonder! Rich, luxurious jacquard-weave fabric, stitched in large biscuit pleats and surrounded by soft, leather-grained vinyl, forms the standard trim for front and rear seats. Front seat also has chromed side shields and assist handles on the seat-back to complete the luxury touch.

Interior door trim is highlighted by modern walnutgrain-textured panels in the armrest areas and rich, pile carpeting below.

Pull-down center armrests are standard on both front and rear seats of Town Sedan and 4-door hardtop models, and on the rear seat of the 2-door hardtop.

Plush, high-back bucket seats, with built-in adjustable headrest on passenger seat, are optional on New Yorker hardtops with either all-vinyl or cloth-andvinyl trim. The headrest has a 5-position adjustment to accommodate different size passengers and their

seating preferences. Separate removable headrest for driver's seat is optional.

This option also includes a reclining seat-back for the front-seat passenger. It has a new reclining mechanism that locks the seat-back at any point within its 45-degree range of adjustment. The passenger pushes the adjusting lever and tilts the seat-back to make an adjustment. Rear-seat passengers can enter or leave

merely by pushing the seat-back forward . . . no lever need be released.





Shell-contoured, highback front bucket seats are full-foam padded for maximum comfort . . . the rear compartment has a bench seat with bucket-seat styling. All seats are richly trimmed in vertically pleated leather-grain vinyl. Cloth-and-vinyl trim (Includes recliner seat back and built-in headrest) is available at extra cost for those who prefer it. Leather trim (Includes recliner seat-back and built-in headrest) is an extra-cost option. A fixed center cushion and pull-down armrest between the front bucket seats are standard, affording three-passenger seating up front. Door panels are trimmed in leather-grain vinyl and carpeting.

Reclining Front Passenger Seat, an option on cloth and vinyl or leather bucket seat models, has a new adjustment mechanism that locks the seat-back at any point within its 45° range of travel. Instead of relying on a notched adjusting rod, the new mechanism has a sliding lock that operates similar to the stop used on a storm-door closer. The passenger merely presses the adjusting lever, tilts the seat-back to the position he wants, then releases the lever. On 2-door models, pushing the seat-back forward releases the locking mechanism so passengers can enter and leave the rear compartment without having to work the adjusting lever. 





Extruded Aluminum Roof Luggage Rack, with adjustable tie-down bar, is an option that greatly increases the carrying capacity of a Town & Country Wagon. The adjustable tie-down bar can be moved to the best location for securing each individual load, whether it's small or large. And, the modern style and brushed finish of the roof luggage rack enhances the beauty of any wagon.

Power-operated Tail-gate Window is a standard feature on the Town & Country Wagon. It can be raised or lowered with the turn of a key in the tail-gate lock cylinder, or by flicking a switch located on the instru-

ment panel within easy reach of the driver. It provides a real convenience for loading small packages at the rear without lowering the tail gate, and for providing flow-through ventilation without leaving the driver's seat.

Dual Air Conditioner, optional with Town & Country Wagons, has an additional roof-mounted unit behind the second seat. This unit has separate cooling coils and blowers that cool and re-circulate the air at the rear of the wagon. Dual air conditioning is recommended for wagons operated in hot climates.



Folding Seats For Cargo Hauling in a Town & Country Wagon is an easy task even for a woman. The illustrations at right show how seats look in their raised position, being folded and when they're down. Here's how it's done:

- Release the latch at either side of the second seat-back.
- Fold the second seat-back forward as shown in picture two. As the seat-back moves forward, a spring-loaded, hinged panel folds down to form the floor behind the seat-back and to lock the seat-back in the cargo position.
- 3. Open the tail gate and pull the third seat-back toward the rear. Fold the seat-back flush with the floor and press down until it locks in position. A hinged panel, attached to the seat-back completes the floor forward of the seat-back.

Chrysler's Instrument Panel not only is unmistakably premium-line in quality and appearance, it also reflects top-line planning in safety and convenience. The entire top and eyebrow of every Chrysler instrument panel is safety-padded and covered with nonglare vinyl. Instruments and controls are safety-recessed below the padded eyebrow and gauges are large and easy to read. The semi-circle speedometer, directly in front of the driver, has big, white numer-

als on a black background for greater definition and clarity. The car's odometer, plus a trip odometer which is also standard, can be seen at the center of the speedometer dial. Three distinct trim panels are used across the mid-section of the instrument panel: a wood-grain textured trim appears on New Yorker and Town & Country models; a bright vertical-ribbed panel is used on 300; and a suede-like-finish black paint trims the Newport.

Sliding Drawer in Chrysler's instrument panel features a special coin holder for quarters, dimes, nickels and pennies . . . a real convenience for paying bridge and turnpike tolls and parking meters. The drawer also contains two ashtrays and a cigar lighter and is illuminated when opened.



Three-spoke Steering Wheel with a partial horn ring is used for all Chrysler series. The New Yorker steering wheel has wood-grain-textured inserts on the spokes whereas these areas are brightly chromed on Newport, 300 and Town & Country models.




New, Safety Inside Door Release Handle is shaped and operates like the buckle on a safety seat belt. It requires only a slight pull inward to unlatch the door. However, its design provides a definite safety factor. It is mounted flat on the door panel just ahead of the armrest so that there's no handle to grab for support in the event of a sudden stop. Ordinary door handles project from inside the car door and sometimes are grabbed or bumped by passengers bracing themselves for quick stops and impending accidents . . . as a result, the door latch is released, the door pops open and the passenger is ejected from the car. Accident statistics indicate that passengers are less apt to be injured if they remain inside the car.

Custom-positioned Front Seats, a standard feature on Chrysler, have a built-in manual adjuster that permits a 6-way adjustment. The seat can be raised or lowered, moved forward or rearward or tilted to give the owner his best seating and driving position. This is in addition to the normal front-seat adjustment that is made by releasing a lever at the seat base and sliding the seat forward or rearward on inclined tracks.

Crank-operated Vent Windows, on all Chrysler front doors, provide draft-free ventilation when all other windows and vents are closed. Crank handles are geared for easy turning. Internal gearing holds vent window at any set position, even against winds that build up at turnpike speeds.






Variable-speed, Electrically Powered Windshield Wipers, that don't slow down when the car is accelerated, are standard on all Chryslers. And, they operate in parallel . . . both wiper blades move across the windshield in the same direction at the same time . . . rather than in an opposing manner. This lets the wiper blades overlap the center area of the windshield and wipe this critical area clean. The driver gets a clean, wiped windshield from side to side, giving him better visibility. Wiper-blade arms have an anti-windlift design to keep them from lifting off the windshield at highway speeds.

HEATING, DEFROSTING, VENTILATION

Chrysler Air-mix Heater and Defroster, standard on all models, gives immediate response to temperature control adjustments. Moving the temperature control lever to the right causes an instant temperature rise in the incoming air, and moving it to the left causes an instant temperature drop. This quick response is achieved by a two-passage air-intake system . . . one passage heated, the other unheated . . . that mix just before they enter the passenger compartment. Sliding the temperature-control lever moves a damper in the system that mixes heated air with unheated air . . . the action is instant and so is the response in temperature change. Moving the control to the right mixes in more heated air so the temperature goes up.

Four push buttons, labeled OFF, HEAT, MAX HEAT and DEF control the directional flow of the heated air or shut it off entirely. Pushing the MAX HEAT button directs more heated air to the rear-seat compartment. A toggle switch above the push buttons gives three blower speeds and turns the blower off.

When the car is in motion, ram-air heating can be achieved by pushing either the HEAT or DEF button with the blower switch off.



Side-cowl, Fresh-air Ventilators, independent of the car's heating system, direct large volumes of fresh air onto front-seat passengers. Air-flow is regulated or shut off by individual push-pull controls located on either side of the steering column.

NEW, REAR AIR HEAT SYSTEM (Optional)


Overall heating capacity is increased by 20% with Chrysler's new *optional* rear compartment heating system. The increased capacity results from an additional heating radiator mounted in the trunk just below the rear package shelf.

Hot water is circulated from the engine through this radiator by means of half-inch armor-covered steel tubing. The system also includes a centrifugal blower and an air-flow control door that directs air either for heating or defrosting.

Controls for the system are installed on the instrument panel immediately below the standard heater controls... just to the right of the steering column. The control panel is labeled REAR AIR and has two three-position toggle switches. The left toggle selects either HEAT, DEFROST or DEFOG and the right toggle turns the blower to HI, LO or OFF. Moving the left toggle switch to HEAT causes the air-flow control door to direct all the heated air forward through two heating ducts under the rear seat that open into the rear passenger compartment.

When the switch is on DEFROST, all the heated air is directed up onto the rear window. Moving the switch to the DEFOG position shuts off hot-water flow to the rear heater radiator and keeps re-circulated air directed on the rear window.

Air for the system is supplied from inside the car through an air intake in the top of the package shelf.

Front Fender-mounted, Turn-signal Indicator Lights,




standard on New Yorker and Town & Country models, are out front in the driver's line of vision where he is certain to notice them. In this location, the indicator lights provide a quick check for the driver on his selection of turn signals, and also serve as a better reminder to cancel his signal after making a shallow turn that does not actuate the self-cancelling mechanism. Fender-mounted indicator

lights are optional on Newport and 300 models.

The Spare Tire In Chrysler's Big Trunk is stored forward, on the rear axle floor hump, where it doesn't interfere with the main body of the trunk. This leaves the full width of the trunk unobstructed for carrying luggage. In convertibles, the spare tire is moved to the rear to make room for the folding convertible top.

Two-position Door Checks, that hold doors either fully open or part-way open, are standard equipment on front and rear doors of all Chryslers. The intermediate-position door check can be a real convenience when parked closely between other cars where the doors cannot be fully opened. The two-position door checks will also hold the door open on slight grades so that it won't bang closed against your legs when you are entering with an armful of packages.





Three Distinct 2-door Hardtop Roofs are featured in the 1966 Chrysler. The New Yorker 2-door hardtop has long, flat roof with lines similar to the 4-door hardtop. The 300 2-door hardtop roof is more rounded, and the rear roof pillar is slimmer and has more slope than New Yorker's. The Newport 2-door hardtop roof has slim, wedge-shape rear roof pillars, and roof crease lines that give it a convertible look.

Safety Door Reflectors, that warn oncoming traffic at night when a door is opened, are standard on Chrysler 300 models. These reflectors give off a brilliant red glare when headlights shine upon them.



Chrysler's High-capacity Air Conditioner cools the car interior quickly to the comfort level even when it's been parked in the hot sun. And, it has the capacity to keep the interior cool even with six passengers aboard. Perhaps the biggest feature of this air conditioner is its built-in dehumidifying and filtering action that removes moisture, dust and weed pollen from the incoming air. This helps keep passengers dry and clean and comfortable even if they suffer from pollen-induced allergies.

Efficient dehumidifying action is achieved by using the re-heat principle . . . after moisture is condensed out of the air on the cooling coils, heat is added to further reduce the relative humidity. The amount of heat added depends on the positioning of the temperature control lever. On cool, damp days, when cooling is not desired, the air coming into the car can be dehumidified and even warmed to individual comfort levels by the air conditioner and its integral heating unit.

Adjustable cool-air outlets, at the center and at each side of the instrument panel, provide maximum area cooling or personalized comfort.

Controls for the Air Conditioner-Heater System consist of a sliding temperature control lever, a three-speed blower switch and a 5-push-button control panel labeled OFF, MAX COOL, FR COOL, HEAT and DEF.

The MAX COOL button recirculates the air through the cooling coils for quick cool-down and minimum temperatures. The FR COOL button keeps fresh air coming into the car through the cooling coils for normal cooling. The HEAT and DEF buttons shut off the air conditioner and the system operates as a regular heater and defroster.

Tinted Window Glass, that filters out many of the heatproducing rays of the sun, is recommended with air conditioning to make the system more effective. For 1966, the shading across the top of windshields is blue. The blue gives a more natural rendition of colors seen through the shading. This is especially beneficial when looking at overhead traffic lights.

Dual Air Conditioners, available only with Town & Country Wagons, have a rear roof unit which is covered in the Town & Country Wagon section.



Air-conditioner Controls

Electric Door-locking System, available on all Chryslers, both 2- and 4-door models, provides convenience and safety benefits for passengers.

Pushing down on either front-door push button locks all doors simultaneously...electrically. This provides a safety feature for women driving alone at night and is a convenience for anyone. Pulling up on either front-door push button unlocks all doors. Lifting the push button on either rear door unlocks that door only. When leaving the car, just turn the door key in either front door and all doors lock. However, when re-entering the car, the key unlocks only the door in which it is used.

POPULAR OPTIONS (Continued)

Chrysler Radios are all powerful, 5½-watt receivers with strong and clear reception, and are fully transistorized to provide instant play with minimum current usage.

The Golden Tone AM Radio has push-button station selection and a tone control to vary the bass and treble.

The Golden Touch Tuner AM Radio is a search-tuning radio that automatically seeks out and tunes in the next audible station on the radio dial when the search-tune bar on the radio, or a foot button (on the floor near the headlight dimmer switch) are depressed.

Chrysler's AM/FM Radio is a powerful unit that receives either FM or AM programs in clear, high-fidelity fashion.

Rear-seat Speaker and Rear-seat Speaker with Reverberator are available on all models except wagons.

Power-operated Trunk Lid Release, available on all models except wagons, has a remote-control button located in the glove box. Trunk can be opened without using key.



New, 6-way Power Seat Adjuster is optional for both bench and bucket front seats. A single control moves the seat up and down, tilts it and moves it forward and rearward. The new mechanism is stronger and has less tolerance in its gears, providing smoother and quieter operation during seat adjustments.

Power Windows, with 4-button master control panel on driver's door and a single control below the other side windows, are available on all Chryslers.

Power Vent Windows, available on all Chryslers, have a 2-button control on the driver's door and a single control on the passenger's door. They provide smooth, quiet vent window operation.





TILT-A-SCOPE STEERING WHEEL

Chrysler's new adjustable steering wheel can be tilted to any of 6 different driving positions or telescoped in-and-out a total of 2.7 inches. A small lever on the left side of the steering column must be lifted to tilt the wheel. The wheel can be tilted to two positions above the normal driving position and to three positions below. Releasing the lever locks the wheel in the position selected.

A large ring at the center of the steering wheel must be loosened to telescope the wheel in and out. This combination of tilting and telescoping gives the driver an almost infinite variety of steering wheel adjustments. The adjustable wheel has only two spokes. This option is available only with power steering and TorqueFlite. Auto-Pilot For More Relaxed Driving! Driving is more relaxed with a Chrysler Auto-Pilot maintaining car speed at a predetermined rate. You just dial the speed you want and pull out the automatic control knob... as soon as the car reaches the pre-set speed, Auto-Pilot goes into action and maintains that speed. Setting the dial at "6" means that Auto-Pilot will hold the car speed at approximately 60 miles an hour even in hilly country... so the driver can take his foot off the accelerator.

Applying the car brakes or pushing in the control button will disengage the Auto-Pilot and return normal control to the driver.

Auto-Pilot functions as a safety speed reminder when the control knob is "in". The resistance will be felt on the accelerator at the pre-selected speed, but there is no automatic control.

Constant-control Power Steering, standard on New Yorker and Town & Country Wagons, makes steering a fingertip task and gives more responsive steering. It is a recommended option on 300 and Newport models.

Power Brakes, standard on New Yorker, Town & Country Wagons and with disc brakes, take up to 50% of the effort out of braking.

Light Sensing Unit (Photocell)







Safeguard Sentinel Lighting, that automatically turns the headlights and taillights on at twilight or during any period of unusual darkness as during heavy overcasts, is optional on all Chryslers. It also automatically turns the lights off again when the dark period passes and adequate daylight is available for safe driving.

A sensing device, containing a photocell, is mounted on top of the instrument panel to read light intensity and transmit the signal that turns the car lights on or off. A variable time delay switch can be set to allow the car's headlights, taillights, instrument panel lights and backup lights to remain on for up to 2 minutes after the driver has parked his car in the driveway or garage. Thus he can use the car's lights to illuminate his way safely to the house.

3-speed TorqueFlite Automatic Transmission, with proved record of performance, economy, smoothness and reliability, is standard on New Yorker and Town & Country models, optional on 300 and Newport models. Console-mounted selector lever is available on all models with optional console.



Custom Retractable Front and Rear Safety Seat Belts, that roll up the outer strap of the belt like a window shade so it won't dangle out the doorway, are optional on all Chryslers. Straps for the front seat belts roll up into color-keyed vinyl boots.
